### **Insurance Deductible Assistance Program Opens to Homeowners Impacted by Hurricane Ian**

Naples, Fla. --- Collier County is opening applications on Friday, November 18, to assist eligible Collier County residents pay their insurance deductibles if their primary residence sustained damage because of Hurricane Ian. The county received \$334,700 from the State Housing Initiative Partnership (SHIP) Disaster Assistance program to distribute in the community. Applications are to be completed online at [CollierCountyHousing.com](http://CollierCountyHousing.com). The portal will be open from Friday, November 18, at 12 p.m. and close on Saturday, November 26, at 5 p.m.

Applicant’s primary residence must be in Collier County and meet income limits up to 120% area median income (AMI). See chart below. Residential value, according to the Collier County Appraiser, cannot exceed \$458,634.60. The maximum award for a household is \$20,000. A second home and/or rental property do not meet the program requirements.
