INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE AND ROOF REPLACEMENT ASSISTANCE

Homeowner assistance is available! Was your home damaged from Hurricane Ian? Do you need your roof replaced? If you are a homeowner and your primary residence is in Collier County, the City of Naples, Everglades or Marco Island, you may qualify for an insurance deductible grant and/or an interest-free, deferred loan to replace your roof. Qualified and approved applicants could receive up to \$20,000 toward the home's insurance deductible and up to a \$50,000 loan for a roof replacement. Eligibility varies per program but is based on income qualifications first. Go to CollierCountyHousing.com for more information.

If your primary residence before Hurricane Ian was in Collier County and you are currently a county resident, you may qualify for up to \$20,000 in rental assistance through the State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Hurricane Rental program.
